
Basic facts about Congleton Cheshire East settlement

This report provides a summary of the latest available information on the demographic and socioeconomic make-up of the Congleton Cheshire East settlement within Cheshire East. It looks at the population structure and provides information on the economic, housing and educational achievement of the Cheshire East settlement.

Congleton is one of the 25 Cheshire East settlements of Cheshire East. It has an area of 2,255 hectares which represents 1.93% of the total area of Cheshire East Unitary.



Residents


Congleton has a resident population of 26,482 which represents 7.15% of the total Cheshire East resident population of 370,127.

Congleton's resident population is 50.8% female and 49.2% male.



Age

The mean age of the Congleton Cheshire East settlement population is 43 years compared to a mean age of 42 years for residents in the whole of Cheshire East. The predominant age band in Congleton Cheshire East settlement is Age 45 to 59 which represents 20.84% of the population.




Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is 'Number of usual residents who are White' with 98.0% of the Cheshire East settlement's population. That compares with a figure of 96.7% for the Unitary as a whole, 90.2% for the North West Region and 85.4% for all of England.

The second largest ethnic group is 'Number of usual residents who are Asian/Asian British' with 1.1% of the Cheshire East settlement's population. That compares with 1.6% for the Unitary as a whole, 6.2% for the North West Region and 7.8% for all of England.




The ethnic split of Congleton 's residents is shown below.



Households

Congleton Cheshire East settlement has 11,561 households, which represents 7.25% of Cheshire East's 159,441 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in 'Number of all households - Owned outright' accommodation with 38.7% of the Cheshire East settlement's households. That compares with 37.5% for the Unitary as a whole, 28.6% for North West Region and 32.8% for the whole of England.

The second largest number of households lives in 'Percentage of all households - Owned with a mortgage or loan' accommodation with 36.2% of the Cheshire East settlement's households. That compares with 37.0% for the Unitary as a whole, 33.2% for North West Region and 34.5% for the whole of England.

The Cheshire East settlement has 1,185 households with dependent children aged 0 to 4. That represents 10.25% of the Cheshire East settlement's households.




3,103 households in the Cheshire East settlement have 'Dependent children in household: All ages'. That represents 26.84% of the Cheshire East settlement's households.

Employment

The following chart provides a breakdown of the Congleton Cheshire East settlement by socio-economic classification for all residents aged 16 - 74.

The National Statistics Socio-economic Classification (NS-SEC) provides an indication of socio-economic position based on occupation. It is an Office for National Statistics standard classification. To assign a person aged 16 to 74 to an NS-SEC category their occupation title is combined with information about their employment status, whether they are employed or self-employed, and whether or not they supervise other employees. Full-time students are recorded in the full-time students category regardless of whether they are economically active or not.



The largest group is 'National Statistics Socio-Economic Classification - 2. Lower managerial, administrative and professional occupations' representing 16.53% of the Cheshire East settlement's population.




Education



24.14% of Congleton 's residents have achieved level 4 qualifications and above compared to 27.40% in England as a whole and 18.29% of Congleton 's residents have no qualifications compared to 22.50% in England .

Health



Congleton has 1,109 (4.2%) residents that report being in bad health and 303 (1.1%) residents that report being in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 18 (out of 25 Cheshire East settlements) within Cheshire East.
